





The event took place at the newly refurbished Mango Room from 2:00 p.m.










Following the completion of refurbishment works, HADCO Experiences at Asa Wright Nature Centre now offers:




CELEBRATING LOVE WITH HADCO EXPERIENCES

HADCO DONATES TURTLE-FRIENDLY LIGHTS TO GRANDE RIVIERE COMMUNITY

On Tuesday June 6, 2023, HADCO, together with the Grande Riviere Nature Tour Guide Association (GRNTGA), and the Environmental Management Authority (EMA) of Trinidad and Tobago replaced the existing streetlights at Hosang Street in the vicinity of Mt. Plaisir Estate Hotel in Grande Riviere with turtle-friendly lights.

HADCO was happy to donate 20 NXT Lite LED Turtle Friendly Lights – streetlights that emit a red glow to the human eye, at a wavelength invisible to turtles - 17 of which were installed in the immediate vicinity of the turtle nesting site.

The initiative is part of ongoing efforts, by the National Sea Turtle Task Force (NSTTF) and the GRNTGA to ensure the long-term protection and enhancement of the quality of life experienced by the Leatherback turtles (Dermochelys coriacea) which visit our shores annually. Discussions by the NSTTF, regarding the deleterious effect of streetlights on nesting sea turtles at the Grande Riviere beach began in April 2022. Specifically, their nesting patterns were being disturbed by the light pollution from the light waves of regular streetlight units, causing the turtles to become




disoriented or lost inland, when seeking darker areas to lay their eggs.

Grande Riviere is known as the largest Leatherback nesting site in the Caribbean. During the peak of the annual turtle nesting season (March 1 — August 31), five of the seven sea turtle species found globally return to Trinidad's shores. These amazing sea creatures honour their timeless "family tradition" of returning to the place where they were born to lay their eggs.

The resulting "red zone" is the first of its kind for Trinidad and Tobago and it is hoped that other key stakeholders will adopt a similar approach to wildlife conservation and the promotion of Trinidad and Tobago as a true sustainable travel destination.





THE UNDP SUPPORTS HADCO EXPERIENCES IN THE FIGHT AGAINST CLIMATE CHANGE

On Thursday April 6, 2023, the Executive and staff of HADCO Experiences celebrated more than just the launch of the Division at Asa Wright Nature Centre, as they also officially commissioned fourteen low-carbon emission air-conditioning units in the fight against climate change.

Also known as hydrocarbon (R290) airconditioning units, the donation was awarded to HADCO Experiences at Asa Wright Nature Centre by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), through its Global Environmental Facility (GEF) Project. One of the GEF's main objectives is to partner with stakeholders in the preservation and enhancement of our natural environment.

According to Gerardo Noto, Resident Representative – United Nations Development Programme Trinidad and Tobago, Asa Wright Nature Centre was selected as one of the demonstration sites under the Global Environmental Facility (GEF) Project, to install the units with the aim of reducing carbon emissions and consequently, the depletion of the ozone laver.

HADCO AWARDED GRANT FUNDING FOR SUSTAINABLE WILDLIFE **FOURISM PROJECT**

On Monday June 12, 2023, the Ministry of Planning and Development, in partnership with the European Union (EU), the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB Lab) and the Caribbean Industrial Research Institute (CARIRI) hosted an awards ceremony for the recipients of the second call for grant funding, under the Shaping the Future of Innovation project.

The event was held at the Hyatt Regency, Port of Spain and guests included the Commonwealth Secretary-General, the Right Honourable Patricia Scotland, KC, the Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Germany, Her Excellency Ute König, Minister of Planning and Development the Honourable Pennelope Beckles-Robinson, and the Chief of Operations - IDB Trinidad and Tobago, Mr. Sergio Rios.

The Shaping the Future of Innovation Project is described as an initiative of the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, the EU and IDB LAB in collaboration with CARIRI as the executing agency. The programme targets registered local businesses and organisations from the small and medium enterprises sector that can demonstrate a commercial track record and have the potential to deliver innovative goods and services which support socioeconomic development.

HADCO was therefore recognised for its use of photovoltaic solar panels as part of restorative works at the ecolodge and trails of Asa Wright Nature Centre. As a sector, tourism stakeholders consume massive amounts of energy and as such, the use of an alternative lighting system that does not produce waste or release greenhouse gases, will aid in the preservation of the natural environment and improve the health of guests and staff.

Mrs. Varisha Rambaran, Group Corporate Communications Manager at HADCO Group received the award certificate on behalf of HADCO Holdings Limited for its project which was titled Sustainable Wildlife Tourism.

SENSITISATION TRAINING ON VENOMOUS BITES

HADCO Experiences kicked off the month of March with Sensitisation training for their staff which was held at HADCO's Administrative Building in San Juan.



The sessions were completed ahead of the launch of HADCO Experiences at Asa Wright Nature Centre in April and the re-opening of the ecolodge, to further ensure that staff are comfortable and knowledgeable about the details and operations surrounding their natural work environment.


