## A look inside of our new End-of-Life Tyre Recycling Facility

It has been a busy couple of months for HADCO's Recycling Division! Nonetheless, we are pleased to announce that we are pre-commissioning our End-of-Life Tyre Recycling Facility and are testing all mechanical equipment.

According to Kevin Whiteman, Managing Directer, HADCO Recycling Division, "It is important for us to understand the capacity of the machinery before we go fully live." He further noted that "Since a project of this scale has not fully been realised on the island before, we want to start up the plant to ensure we can meet the needs of our country."

It is estimated that 1.5 million used tyres are disposed of every year in Trinidad and Tobago, and hopefully, our new End-of-Life Tyre Recycling Facility can help responsibly dispose of these bulky waste tyres through various degrees of shredding.
