## 2023 Recycling Recap -Our Record-Breaking Collection Year

2023 was our best-ever year for waste collections! HADCO's Recycling Division collected over 8 million kilograms of waste materials which is an increase of 33.33% more than 2022.

Clocking in an approximate total of 8,979,030 kilograms of waste collected, our data underscores a great shift in consumers, manufacturers, and business owners alike – Trinidad and Tobago's recycling habits are changing.

Of the eight types of waste material collected, the number one material was corrugated cardboard, and number two was wastepaper. The diagram on the following page illustrates the type of waste and respective quantity processed.
